June minutes were approved.

Emerald Ash Borer: On June 17 Matt Langlais, Caledonia County forester, trained the commission on identifying ash trees. Joanne Garton from FPR sent links to the state site. On June 25 the commission inventoried ash trees on Darling Hill and Burke Green Roads from the Lyndon to Newark town lines. We noted the trees' size, condition and the probable effect to traffic if a tree fell in the road.

Matt Clark, of Whiteout Solutions, will do the same inventory using a drone, the first or second week of August. Elise will send a link to Commission members so we can view and download data collected.

This is a pilot study. We will compare the information from the on foot inventory to inventory by drone to see if it will be useful to the town in anticipating EAB damage.

Pete's Pond

Mike will convey our interest in conserving the area to the DRB and Planning Board. Is there a permitting process underway?

Working with other boards: Mike will send our minutes to the other boards and their minutes to us.
