SELECTMEN'S MEETING
Burke Town Clerk's Office

PRESENT: Sam Sanderson, Darryel Corrow, Emery Noyes, Will Ware, Nancy Taylor (Chamber member), Jack Davis, Mike Harris.

Sam opened the Selectmen's meeting with the reading of the August meeting minutes. Emery made a motion to accept the minutes as submitted. Darryel seconded. All in favor.

ROAD FOREMAN REPORT – Will told the board that he had been trying out a rubber tired excavator that a dealer had offered for trial. They have been doing some road work and he really likes it.

He also told the board that they had been doing sandblasting on the town trucks. Dale's truck has been out of commission for a while and as soon as it gets back they would be sandblasting that one also. Will is doing the priming and painting. They will then do the rubbish truck at a later time.

Nancy Taylor: came before the board to ask if the board would give permission to the chamber to do a road run race on Town Roads. She has not mapped out the route yet until she got permission from the board. She said they were trying to bring new interest into town during the mud season and thought they would incorporate that with mud and sugaring season. She was thinking of calling the event "The Mud, Moose and Maple Run". The Board said that they have no problem with this and just to keep them informed.

Jack Davis: Jack came to the board to ask if they wouldn't consider putting a stop sign the bottom of the East Darling Hill Road where it intersects with the Burke Hollow Road. Sam had some concerns about the traffic coming from 114 Rte and wants to shoot across the Burke Hollow Road on to the East Darling Hill Road. After much discussion, the Board will look into the possibilities and remedies as to what signs to use.

VISITORS: **Mike Harris** came before the Board to see what the status was on the Ruggles property. Sam told him the our lawyer is in the process of writing a letter informing Mr. Ruggles that he can not accumulate anymore junk or the Town will be taking the case to Superior Court. He has cleaned up most of his property since he got a letter a few weeks ago from the lawyer.

There was also discussion on the letter of complaint submitted by Sherry Noyes concerning Mike Mathers still having overnight campers in the Village. He does not have a permit to run a campground.

CONSTABLE REPORT: Paul told the board that he had been busy over the last week end. He assisted the State Police in an incident in town. He has done patrolling in town as usual.

ZONING ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: Doug was not present.

OTHER BUSINESS: ** The Board signed a cemetery confirmation.

** Signed the USGS Joint Funding Agreement for 2015 in the amount of \$15,000.00.

The Board discussed future use of the Ham house rental property. They plan to notify the current tenants that the building will be torn down so that they can build the equipment storage building in that space. The tenants will get a formal letter informing them of the time frame.
